These top five spots have been rounded up according to TripAdvisor reviews. No matter if you're a pepperoni craver or a pineapple advocate, West Sussex has plenty of pizza restaurants and takeaways to choose from.

Five of the best places to get pizza in West Sussex:

Village Pizza Kitchen

Where: 126C High Street, Hurstpierpoint, Hassocks, BN6 9PX

Village Pizza Kitchen serves artisan biga pizza and homemade pasta dishes featuring highquality British ingredients, available for takeaway and delivery. It's passionate about showcasing amazing British produce and supporting local producers, which is reflected in many of the ingredients used on its menu.

Rating: 5 Star

Filippo's Italian Restaurant

Where: 5A Park Place, Horsham, RH12 1DF

Filippo's is an independent, family-run restaurant offering authentic Italian cuisine. All of its meals are freshly cooked to order.

Rating: 4.5 Star

Review: "Lovely atmosphere, the host was amazing, and the food was incredible making us feel very Italian! We shared a margarita pizza, and it was so delicious! They were so kind hanging our coats up for us to dry and very welcoming. Overall, 10/10 experience and will definitely be going back again in the future."

Enzo Fiore Italian Restaurant & Pizzeria O' Curniciello

Where: 6/7 Queensway, Lancing, BN15 9AY

Enzo Fiore is an international chef, who trained internationally through travelling. He has opened and managed multiple restaurants in exotic locations across the globe, Enzo Fiore Italian Restaurant & Pizzeria being one of them.

Rating: 5 Star

Review: "Me and my family have had the most amazing meal tonight. Everything from the minute we arrived to the minute we left was perfect. The best authentic Italian produce and the loveliest, caring staff. We will be back."

Pizzaface Worthing

Where: 138 Montague Street, Worthing, BN11 3HG

Pizzaface was started in 2009 by a chef and a graphic designer. It has since opened three branches and created a unique menu specialising in showcasing bold flavours and interesting ingredients and taking pride in making everything by hand.

Rating: 4.5 Stars

Review: "Absolutely delicious pizza. We had the Albore pizza, which was divine, never had rosemary on a pizza before, it works really well. We also had the Margherita with artichoke, so tasty. We had a garden salad too, very generous with the olives and sundried tomatoes. All washed down with a couple of beers ... divine. I love this restaurant, the atmosphere is great, the staff are really friendly and helpful."

La Piazetta

Where: 5 Bishopric, Horsham, RH12 1QA

La Piazetta's food is made fresh and mostly from local producers, this gives it the edge when preparing seasonal dishes. Autumn, Winter, Spring or Summer, its food's main ingredients are always available.

Rating: 4.5 Stars

Review: "A fabulous meal. We ordered the Quattro Stagioni pizza and the Salmon Fettuccini. Both were absolutely delicious. Really sad when I had my last mouthful. The service was excellent (attentive staff and quick delivery of food) and we really enjoyed the calm and relaxing atmosphere (unlike the local chain Italian restaurant that we'd checked out which was extremely loud). At £12.95 per each main course the meal was great value for money."
